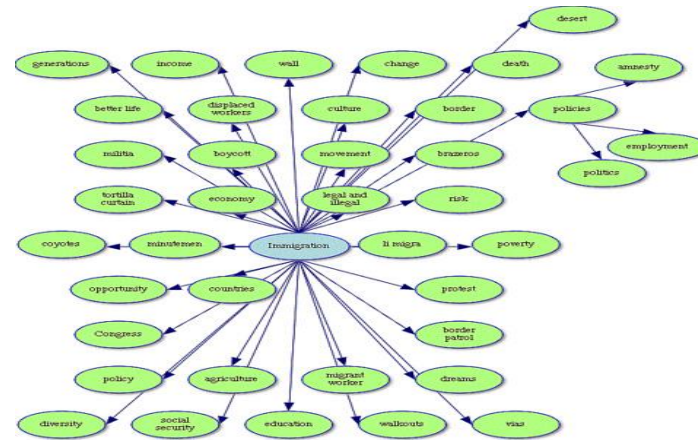


# Vocabulary Challenge

Answer: 16

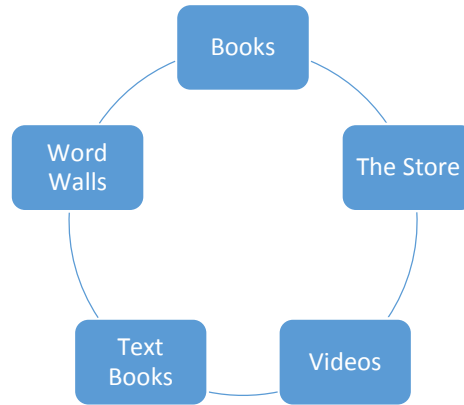
This year we are challenging our students to

Will you take this challenge?

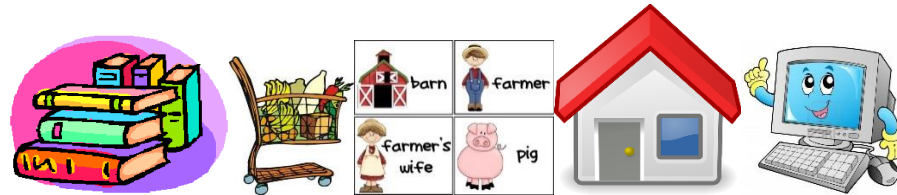


- All you need is a Notebook.

- Tell a friend, teacher or your family about the new word(s) you learn
- You may need to look up the word in a dictionary or use a thesaurus. Guess what... You may learn some more new words to add to your list!
- Make a tally chart of the number of words you learn each week and write the number the bottom of your 5<sup>th</sup> page every Friday.
